Senior Prom 2016 guest passes due by April 11 <u>Berkeley High School Guest Pass</u> <u>Rules and Instructions</u>



A COMPLETED guest pass must be presented by the BHS student who is purchasing tickets for the event. Without the form properly completed, a ticket for a guest from outside Berkeley High School cannot be purchased and the guest will not be permitted at the event.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The guest must meet and agree to the following rules and regulations:

- 1.) Students must not have any discipline issues prior to the event at their accredited institution.
- 2.) Guests must be 20 years of age or younger.
- 3.) Guests must have a valid ID for entry into the event.
- 4.) Ins and outs will not be permitted.
- 5.) BHS administrators or safety officers reserve the right to deny a guest initial entry to the event before or at the event. If this is the case, a refund will be given.
- 6.) Use of, under the influence, or possession of drugs or alcohol, fighting, or possession of dangerous items will result in immediate expulsion from the event and summoning of the proper authorities.
- 7.) Guests must abide by any additional rules specific to the event as written on event information sheets and on signs at the event.
- 8.) Anyone who fails to abide by the rules and expectations of Berkeley High School and those outlined above will be escorted out the event at the discretion of supervising adults. No refund will be given.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION

A. On the backside, titled "BHS Guest Pass":

- 1. Fill out the student and guest basic information.
- 2. Have the guest's school administrator sign the form showing their approval.
- 3. If the guest is not in school, have two references leave their info on this form.
- 4. Be sure the BHS student and the guest read and sign the statements of understanding.

B. Attach the following to the BHS Guest Pass:

- 1. A copy of the guest's school administrator's business card (if guest is a student).
- 2. Photocopy of a valid ID card for the guest (school ID, driver's license, passport, or other official ID). Ask your school, library, or a local copy shop to make a copy.

C. Once all info is provided and documents attached:

- 1. Make a final review of the rules and regulations once again before the event.
- 2. The BHS student must present the BHS Guest Pass and attached documents when purchasing a ticket for his/her guest <u>no later than three days before the event</u>.
