

Frequently Asked Questions

Signing up for Winter Sports tryouts

Sign up *now* and no later than October 31. Registration closes October 31.

Where do I find Family ID to register?

Once you have registered on Family ID you will receive an email stating that your registration is "COMPLETE". If you do not receive this, check to make sure you completed all parts of the registration and submit.

COMPLETE does not mean APPROVED.

Where can I get the form for the doctor to fill out?

A form for your doctor to fill out granting clearance to participate is located on the Berkeley High School Website, Athletics tab. You can download it there and give to the doctor to fill out and sign.

How do I upload my signed medical clearance to Family ID registration?

Follow the instructions on Family ID to upload your medical clearance. You can scan the form or take a picture and upload it. If you register before you have the form, you can go back and edit your completed (not yet approved) registration. If you have trouble uploading the form you can contact the Family ID support email or phone number.

Can I bring in my copy of the form instead of uploading?

For Winter Sports we need to have the Doctor's clearance uploaded to the Family ID registration. If you are having difficulty doing that, first call or email Family ID for support. If you need additional help you can bring your hard copy of the form to the Coaches room (J205 - Stadium Building) on **Wednesday, October 18th and Tuesday, October 24th 5:00-7:00 p.m.**

How will I know I'm approved?

The Athletic Director's office will APPROVE students for Winter tryouts. You will not be given a yellow card.

In order to be approved you must:

- Have a completed Family ID registration
- Have uploaded a valid physical (signed, dated and stamped by a doctor)

- Have a Quarter 1 GPA of 2.0 or higher

I completed my registration and uploaded my physical, why haven't I been approved?

Once the Athletic Director reviews the registration and the physical, you will be notified via email if there is anything missing. Your Quarter 1 grades will also be reviewed. If all three things are in order then you will be approved.

What GPA in Quarter 1 do I need to tryout?

You must be enrolled in 20 credits and have a minimum GPA of 2.0. If these two things are not true, you are considered ineligible and will not be allowed to tryout.

If I am ineligible, can I be on a team and not play in games?

Ineligibles will not be able to participate in the tryouts 11/6-11/10. If they talk to the coach and coach is willing to enter into an academic contract with them so that they can practice with the team, then they will be required to meet with Athletics Academic Support Counselor James Metzger to establish a plan. Then the Athletic Director can consider signing off on the plan and the player's participation.

How will the Coach know I'm approved if I don't get a yellow card from the Athletic Director?

Winter coaches will receive a list of all APPROVED students on Nov. 6th. Students who are not approved will not be able to tryout for Winter Sports.

What if I didn't go to school here last year, all year long? (study abroad, new to BHS - does not include 9th graders)?

You may try out, make a team and practice with the team, but cannot participate in any competition with other schools until transfer paperwork for the League is completed with the Athletic Director. Please send an email to athleticdirector@berkeley.net to arrange a meeting.

Can I go to tryouts if I haven't completed the registration on Family ID?

NO! NO! NO! YOU CAN'T!

When are tryouts?

Tryouts will begin on November 6 and are scheduled to go all week. Some coaches may have shortened tryout dates. You are expected to be at all tryout sessions that are arranged.

Where are tryouts?

Times and locations for tryouts will be set by coaches closer to the date and will be posted on the etree, outside the AD office and on the Berkeley High School Website, Athletics tab.

If I tried out for a Fall Sport and was approved on Family ID am I ready for Winter tryouts?

If you have already registered for Family ID for Fall tryouts/sports and uploaded your physical (or brought it to AD office before Fall tryouts) you still must be approved again for Winter sports. Your Quarter 1 grades must be checked and your doctor clearance confirmed. If you are not sure if you selected a winter sport when you registered on Family ID, please contact the AD office: athleticdirector@berkeley.net

If you registered on Family ID for Fall sports but did not select a Winter (or Spring) sport, please DO NOT create another registration on Family ID. The AD office can help adjust your registration.

What if I want to tryout for a Spring sport?

You may go ahead and register on Family ID for a spring sport and upload your physical, but Spring sport athletes will not be Approved until the Semester 1 grades are in and reviewed.
