Excluded from The Faculty Club, women faculty led by Dean of Women Students Lucy Ward Stebbins received permission from President David Prescott Barrows in 1919 to form "a club of their own." Now, 100 years later, our Club still flourishes and is the only remaining Women's Faculty Club in the nation with its own building.

Throughout 2019, the Club will celebrate its centennial with special events that bring its past to life. Remember that it was also in 1919 that the 19th Amendment to the Constitution was passed by Congress and later ratified in 1920, the goal of which was to provide all women with the right to vote! Our events and programs will explore the history, politics, literature, art and music of the Club's 100 years. For women and men alike, there will be much to learn and enjoy in the celebration of our 100 years.
