The Women's Faculty Club was founded in 1919 by women faculty members who were the first of whatever they did on campus. Their vision was to create a space in which they could flourish.

Today, that vision extends to the entire Berkeley campus. All faculty, staff, Departments and alums may become members, enjoying delicious food at lunch, hosting special events, providing hotel rooms for their guests and visitors. And, the Club's series of musical offerings and academic speakers and panels are open to the entire community.

We are celebrating the Club's Centennial with special Centennial Events about women leaders on campus, the women's suffrage movement, pioneering women faculty, and women's contributions to the culture of the 1920's.

But the Club faces a serious challenge. The almost 100 year old building requires significant (and expensive) extension of our event space, repair, restoration and maintenance. The Club's first major fundraising drive - The Next Century Campaign, with a goal of one million dollars - was launched in 2016 to raise funds for our building. In just 3 years we have raised \$750,000 in gifts and pledges. These funds have been spent on the creation of a concrete patio for special events, an ADA compliant pathway and lighting for members and guests, ADA compliant restrooms, reupholstering for the Board Room and the Lounge, and myriad repairs in the building. There is more to be done, including a much needed replacement of our roof.
